

Chris De Hous is leaving Trasys

Chief Executive Officer Chris De Hous (51) of the Belgian ICT service provider Trasys, recently acquired by The NRB Group, is leaving the company on the 31st of December 2015. He has the ambition to go for a CEO function in another company.

Chris De Hous, industrial engineer and Master of Business Administration, has been CEO of Trasys since 2009. Trasys became an independent company in 2006 after a management buyout in collaboration with the investment companies Ackermans & Van Haaren (AvH) and the Nationale Portefeuillemaatschappij (NPM). Trasys was originally the IT-department of Tractebel Engineering (part of the GDF-Suez Group, known as Engie today). Before joining Trasys, Chris De Hous was a partner at the consultancy company McKinsey & Company, where he worked for almost twelve years.

The NRB Group signed an agreement in July 2015 to acquire all shares of the Trasys Group. In October 2015 the Belgian Competition Authority gave its green light to this operation. Thanks to this acquisition The NRB Group is strengthening its position as one of the major Belgian ICT-service providers, realising a turnover of about 300 million euro with about 2000 employees.

"My work is done by the end of this year", says Chris De Hous. "I want to thank my Trasys colleagues for the collaboration during all these years. It is time for me now to make a new step in my career."
